

Council Property Fees

All facilities have a \$50 refundable security deposit with the exception of the Nature Center at Camp Del O'Claire and Red Arrow Lodge at Camp Sacajawea (\$100).

- Day use is defined as up to eight (8) hours of use within one day.
- Overnights are from 3:30 p.m. on the first day to 2 p.m. the next day.
- Non-profit organizations/schools/government agencies are allowed to use our facilities. The security deposit and rental fee will be two times the amount listed.
- For profit organizations are also allowed to rent our facilities at four times the amount listed along with the \$100 security deposit.
- All camps (except Camp Winnecomac) will be closed during the nine (9) day (15 day in Michigan) deer hunting season.
- There is no fee for any Service Center rental for three hours or less on Sunday evening through Thursday nights.
