

Council Properties and Activities



Camp Birch Trails

Located in the Town of Rock Falls, approximately eight miles north of Merrill, WI, this is our largest camp! The camp surrounds Lake Olivotti (a man-made lake), which highlights many summer programs. The camp has two lodges, platform tents, cabins, yurts, large dining hall, a swimming area on the lake with a sandy beachfront and large dock, and a sledding hill for winter fun. Tents, boats, canoes, and kayaks are also available for use at the camp. During the winter months, groomed cross-country ski trails and a limited number of snowshoes are available for use.



Camp Blueberry Knoll

Located in Houghton, MI, the camp has a pavilion with primitive camping sites. Tents and equipment are available for use in the storage building on site.



Camp Cuesta

Lots of woodland and an open field for fun and games at this camp! There is a heated troop house, tent cabins and some tent sites available to rent. A screened pavilion is also available for use. In the winter, cross country skis are available to use. The camp is located near Kangaroo Lake and is not far from Baileys Harbor, WI.



Camp Del O'Claire

Located in the Village of Weston, WI, and bordered on the south by the main tributary of the Eau Claire River there are plenty of woods to explore here. The camp is located next to the Yellow Banks County Park, which has a large field and playground equipment. One lodge is available for overnights while there is another lodge available for day use. A nature center also adorns this property along with some camp sites. Tents and outdoor cooking equipment are also available for use. During the winter months, a limited number of snowshoes are available for use.



Camp Hy-Da-Way

A wooded property in Manistique, MI, Camp Hy-Da-Way has a small heated troop house and some platform tents. The camp is located across the road from Indian Lake State Park where there are many hiking trails to explore and a variety of educational programs during the summer season.



Camp Ishnala

55 miles north of Green Bay, there are plenty of woodlands, an open field, hiking trails, and Memory Lake at this property. The camp features a troop house, tent cabin units and some tent sites. It also features a large shelter and an amphitheater. During the summer, keep yourself busy by hiking, canoeing and boating. In the winter, strap on those cross country skis available on site and explore this camp!



Camp Nawakwa

Located northwest of Cornell, WI, this property contains three lodges, a dining hall with a lower level multi-purpose room, yurts, platform tents, tent cabins, and an amphitheater. There are hiking trails, a large play field, waterfront area on Picnic Lake, ponds, and a glacial kame.



Camp Pow-Low

Located in Gwinn, MI, 1200 ft. of lake front property highlights this property. There is a large troop house, platform tents, Adirondack cabins, and a pavilion. There are canoes, kayaks, row boats, and hiking trails to use here.



Camp Sacajawea

Lots of forest and Lake Tapawingo highlight this property. This camp includes three lodges, cabins, platform tents, and tent sites. There are plenty of trails through the forests and ponds to explore with canoes at this camp located in Wisconsin Rapids. In the winter, there are cross country skis and snowshoes available for your use!



Camp Winnecomac

Just northwest of Appleton, this camp is located in Kaukauna, WI. The camp has two main lodges, tent cabins, yurts, and unit shelters. Surrounded by trails of the 1,000 Island Nature Preserve, there is plenty of hiking to do here! During the winter, some of these trails are maintained for cross country skiing; however, please note that you will need to bring your own cross country skis.



Appleton Service Center

Located on the north side of Appleton, the property is adjacent to a nature preserve. Prairies adorn the property, and there is access to miles of hiking trails at the nature preserve. These trails are groomed in the winter for cross country skiing and snowshoeing. Rentals are available through the preserve. There are two large rooms that are available to rent at this Service Center. These rooms can also be divided into smaller rooms, if necessary.



Eau Claire Service Center

With easy access off of Highway 53, this Service Center is ideal for those meetings and special day events! It is located near the shopping district with access to many restaurants.



Green Bay Service Center

Easily accessible from Highways 172 and I-43, this property has a large lower level activity room available for overnights. It can also be divided into two smaller rooms, if necessary. There are many activities nearby including a wildlife sanctuary, amusement park and many parks.
