

COVID-19 Lodging Capacities—to allow for 6-foot physical distance

- Create at least six feet of space between beds whenever possible. If utilizing head-to-toe orientation (see below) four feet of space between beds is acceptable.
- Minimize the number of people sleeping in a space by converting common spaces to sleeping areas whenever possible.
- Position sleepers head-to-toe or toe-to-toe to maximize distance between heads/faces:
 - Bunk beds—position the head of the camper in the top bunk opposite the position of the camper in the bottom bunk.
 - Side-by-side beds—position the head of the camper in one bed opposite the position of the camper in the adjacent bunk.
 - End-to-end beds—position with toes of each camper close to toes of the next camper.
