



Girl Scouts of the Northwestern Great Lakes Scholarship

Each of Girl Scouts of the Northwestern Great Lakes (GSNWGL) five regions will have \$1000 in scholarship funds available. This can be awarded as one \$1000 scholarship or two \$500 scholarships at the discretion of each region's scholarship committee.

Applicant requirements:

- Registered Girl Scout in GSNWGL's Council footprint
- At least two years of high school Girl Scout membership
- Academic achievement of 3.0 or higher
- Girl Scout accomplishments of note, such as becoming a program aide or camp counselor, facilitating a major service project, earning high awards, etc.
- Notable volunteer community service activity
- Application to an accredited institution of continuing education
- Essay (minimum 500-words) describing the impact of the Girl Scout experience now and into the future
- One letter of reference (non-relative)
- Current photo for promotional purposes of scholarship recipients
- Completed application, cover sheet, and checklist

**For Applicants who have earned the Gold award in the Appleton or Central regions:*

Richard J. Leonard College Scholarship

If you have earned the Gold Award and reside in our Central or Appleton regions (served out of the Wausau or Appleton Service Centers) you will also be considered for the Richard J. Leonard Scholarship. This is a one year, \$200 scholarship, given to an exemplary 12th grade Girl Scout residing in these areas who has earned the Gold Award. All eligible applicants will be considered, no additional application is necessary.
